### *A Letter from the Editor...*

The Meriden Ski Club Board of Directors meets every first Tuesday of every month. Every member of the Board works hard on many activities and tries to run a club with hundreds of members with a very large budget. It strives to make skiing an enjoyable event while offering economical trips and events that all members can enjoy. The board wants to give back to its members, especially those who participate in its many activities.

With that said, the Board has looked at two areas: 1). How can we give back to its members, and 2). Where it can stop spending money so that it can do No. 1. The former, we see happening everywhere with subsidized bus trips, lift tickets, parties, Monday night racing, clinics, club races, etc. We are refining policies for refunding money on weekend trips and for the distribution of solicited lift tickets and equipment donations. Below are the policies as they have been written to date and approved by the board.

For No. 2 above, the Board has looked at where it can save money, or at least spend it more wisely. One major savings for the club is the elimination of the hardcopy newsletter. The cost for printing, folding, stapling, labeling, sealing, stamping and mailing the newsletter was between \$300 and \$600 per month, with the folding, labeling, sealing & stamping as free labor done by willing members on meeting nights. While the board recognizes that not all members have electronic access to email and the internet, most do. Email is the No. 1 marketing tool, it is fast and efficient and free. You will have access to the newsletter the day after it is finalized and complete. Updates & reminders are emailed thru out the month. There is no faster way for the club to get the word out to its members. Period.

By providing your email address, which will not be published, you are helping to save the MSC thousands of dollars that can be utilized elsewhere, maybe even putting the money back in your own pocket. ### **Weekend Trip Reimbursement Program**

It is the purpose of the Meriden Ski Club to provide economical skiing opportunities to its members. To this end, the Board of Directors has instituted a program for the 2006-2007 year to reimburse back to one adult member, the cost of the weekend trip actually paid to the Club. A random drawing will be performed and the reimbursement will be made after the trip has returned.

### **Lift Ticket and Equipment Donation Program**

All items received by any member of the Meriden Ski Club from ski areas, ski shops, restaurants, lodging establishments, club members, etc. that were solicited, in the name of the Meriden Ski Club, shall be distributed to members and qualified guests in an equitable manner. No items solicited, under the name of the Meriden Ski Club, may be kept or used by any club member for their personal use.

#### **Distribution of said items shall be as follows:**

To members in good standing or qualified guests by means of a lottery type drawing. Such drawings shall be open to all adult members and qualified guests present at said drawing. Chances shall be distributed in an equitable manner to insure an equal chance to all participants.

Items solicited for the annual Open House shall be distributed by lottery type drawing as follows:

1. A majority of items, deemed by the event chairperson, shall be awarded at the Open House;
2. Some items, determined by the Chairperson, will be distributed at club meetings;
3. Remaining items shall be distributed at the Holiday party.

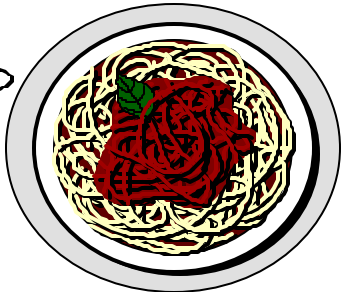
